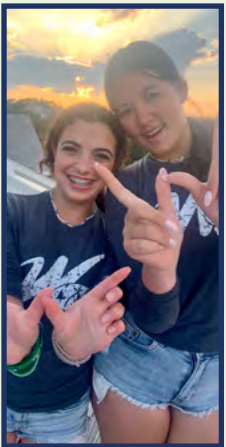

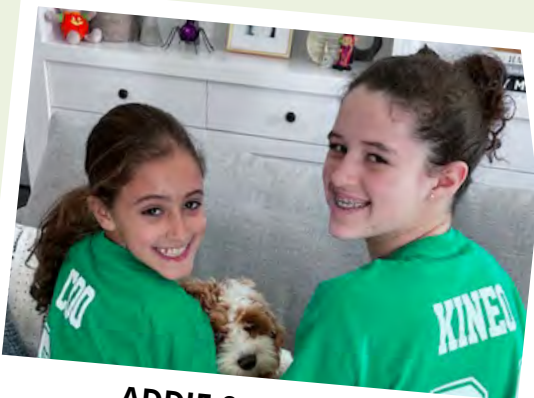

Wico Cares

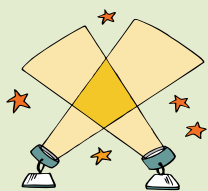

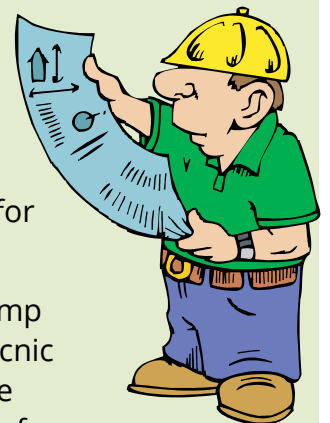
