POSITION:

Activity Heads (AHs) at Camp Wicosuta are vital Leadership Team members who directly supervise staff in a specific program area. AHs oversee all aspects, including curriculum development, staff scheduling, equipment, and department maintenance. They work with campers aged 7 to 15, ensuring activities are safe, fun, and age-appropriate.

As a member of the leadership team, each AH is not only a leader within their program area but around the entire camp community. It is expected that AHs have a strong presence at camp, attending and participating in camp meals, special events and evening on-duty rotations (9:30pm-12:30am)

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Deliver engaging activity programs to campers.
- Plan and implement lessons in a specific field.
- Direct set up and maintenance of the activity area.
- Conduct daily safety checks for equipment and good repair; clean the area daily
- Train activity staff during orientation and throughout the summer; provide formal performance reviews for performing arts counselors.
- Supervise staff instruction during activity periods.
- Organize and create staff schedules.
- Assist in setting up and leading evening activities and special events.
- Lead off-camp trips, supervising counselors and campers as needed.
