### POSITION:

Group Leaders are responsible for overseeing the well-being of 30-50 campers within a specific age group. Group Leaders manage daily routines, provide individualized care, and assist with staff management. They serve as assistant supervisors to Head Counselors, offering ongoing coaching and problem-solving to 8-15 staff members. Group Leaders reside in a cabin with campers and staff, contributing to a cohesive camp environment. Apply now for a leadership role in creating memorable summer experiences.

### RESPONSIBILITIES:

- **Supervision and Camper Care:**
  - Oversee specific camper and staff groups.
  - Support camper care in behavior, disputes, homesickness, diet, and hygiene.
- **Counselor Support and Communication:**
  - Assist Head Counselor with staff evaluations and relationship building.
  - Host daily/weekly age group meetings.
  - Ensure campers receive daily announcements and crucial information.
  - Help facilitate trainings during Staff Orientation
- **Program Collaboration and Execution:**
  - Collaborate on evening programs, special events, and camp activities.
  - Review and file weekly camper questionnaires and progress sheets.
