

Non-Bunk Activity Counselor

SEASONAL: MID JUNE – MID AUGUST



POSITION:

A non-bunk activity counselor at Camp Wicosuta holds a dual role both within a programming setting and larger community aspect of camp.

All staff work in one of our activity areas including athletics, aquatics (pool and waterfront), equestrian, visual arts, performing arts, tennis, outdoor education, ropes course, and more. Our counselors assist in the planning and implementation of instruction in their specific activity area. Counselors work with campers between the ages of 7 and 15 with various abilities and skills. Counselors ensure that activities are safe, fun, and appropriate to the camper's age and abilities. Counselors assist in the management of their activity department's facilities/equipment.

In addition, all non-bunk activity counselors help support the larger Camp Wicosuta community by helping out with various tasks while in-bunk counselors as with campers during bunk time.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Deliver an engaging camp program to campers
- Implement and enforce Camp Wicosuta rules and safety procedures
- Assist in the management and care of the physical facilities and equipment in specific program area
- Serve as caretaker for groups of campers, ensuring day-to-day safety and physical and emotional well being of all campers and staff
- Provide private lessons and/or early morning sessions in activity areas where applicable
- Help with distributing snacks
- Providing support to campers during meal times
- Leading or assisting in daily evening activities
- Helping with maintenance tasks, setting up and breaking down of events, and other logistical support to ensure the overall functioning of camp.

SCHEDULE & SALARY:

This is a temporary, seasonal position on-site in Hebron, New Hampshire from late-May/early-June to mid-August. The salary is competitive and includes housing, meals, and additional staff benefits. For more info, [click here](#).
