POSITION:

The Operations Team at Camp Wicosuta, consisting of an Operations Coordinator and Assistant, collaborates closely with various camp departments to ensure seamless operations. They play a pivotal role in the camp experience's overall success, overseeing critical areas like hospitality, facilities, purchasing, and more. This position is ideal for individuals pursuing degrees in hospitality, business administration, logistics, or related fields.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Execute pre-season planning for camp, coordinating with directors and the program, trips, and transportation teams.
- Organize schedules for the operations department and non-bunk staff.
- Ensure facilities and equipment are well-maintained for staff and campers.
- Conduct daily facility checks for safety & cleanliness, and good repair.
- Assist with computer setup and maintenance.
- Purchase supplies/equipment for the camp season and support Activity Heads (AHs) with ordering.
- Assist with camper and staff programming.
- Assist with logistics of staff orientation, special events, and rainy days and staff-only recreation.
- Support Transportation & Trips Department with vehicle coordination.
- Assist with Check-In and Check-Out of rental vehicles when needed.

SCHEDULE & SALARY:

This is a temporary, seasonal position on-site in Hebron, New Hampshire from mid-June to mid-August. Start dates depend on the specific program area and is based on our seasonal training schedule.
